ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

At Genesis Composites Ltd we aim to operate in a manner which continually tries to reduce any adverse environmental impact. This is achieved in the following ways:-

- i) **Minimisation of Waste**
 - We encourage our employees to plan their work to minimise waste of raw materials and consumables.
 - We control our material purchases to achieve high stock turns and avoid redundant stock.

- ii) **Recycling**
 - Paper is recycled. Where possible paper is re-used.
 - Electronic data transmission - encourage customers to send data by email to reduce excessive paper use.
 - All steel drums and kegs are cleaned and recycled.
 - Boxes for fibreglass mat are recycled together with cardboard tubes from middle of rolls.
 - Timber is reclaimed and re-used. When beyond economic re-use it is recycled through community recycling point.
 - Waste products are disposed of through proper waste routes.

- iii) **Materials**

We endeavour to use materials which have been developed to be more environmentally friendly e.g. low styrene emission resins.

- iv) **Energy**
 - Lighting - fluorescent lighting is used in the factory – keep tubes clean.
 - Heating - is achieved with high efficiency ceramic heaters.
 - Hot water - is provided using on demand heating.

- v) **Vehicles**

Use the right vehicle for the job and try to group tasks together to avoid unnecessary road journeys.

- vi) **Factory Environs**

Gather up litter outside our facilities regularly and keep the buildings tidy.
